Why We Are Different


- We own our facilities.




Clean Earth is **GREEN**: Recycles or beneficially reuses approximately 98% of the material it processes





- Expansive throughput ensures no processing capacity constraints


Backend Placement Capacity

- Continuous identification of new backend locations guarantees available capacity




Competitors Are Narrowly Focused

- Most companies have limited capabilities and can handle a small part of the waste spectrum





- Clean Earth helped make economics work to turn an encumbered property into a premier golf course






















Relationship with Compass
